Noun

Meaning	A person or animal with very pale skin, white hair, and pink eyes due to lack of pigment
Example	The zoo had a rare albino peacock.
Sentence	Albino animals are sensitive to sunlight due to lack of melanin.
Mnemonic	Albino = All white (appearance)
Synonyms	Pale-skinned, Pigmentless
Antonyms	Pigmented, Colored
