

# Amicable

***/ˈæm.ɪ.kə.bəl/***

Adjective

<b>Meaning</b>	Characterized by friendliness and absence of discord
<b>Example</b>	They reached an amicable settlement in court.
<b>Sentence</b>	Their breakup was surprisingly amicable.
<b>Mnemonic</b>	Amicable = Amigo + Cable – friendly connection
<b>Synonyms</b>	Friendly, Peaceable
<b>Antonyms</b>	Hostile, Antagonistic

# Amity

*/ˈæm.ɪ.ti/*

Noun

<b>Meaning</b>	A friendly relationship
<b>Example</b>	The treaty restored amity between the nations.
<b>Sentence</b>	Their amity lasted throughout their lives.
<b>Mnemonic</b>	Amity = Amigo + Unity
<b>Synonyms</b>	Friendship, Harmony
<b>Antonyms</b>	Hostility, Animosity

# Amnesty

*/ˈæm.nə.sti/*

Noun

<b>Meaning</b>	A general pardon for offenses, especially political ones
<b>Example</b>	The government granted amnesty to political prisoners.
<b>Sentence</b>	He was released under a general amnesty.
<b>Mnemonic</b>	Amnesty = Amnesia about past crimes
<b>Synonyms</b>	Pardon, Forgiveness
<b>Antonyms</b>	Punishment, Penalty

# Amorphous

/ə'mɔːfəs/

Adjective

**Meaning** Without a clearly defined shape or form

**Example** The cloud had an amorphous shape.

**Sentence** Their ideas were still amorphous and unorganized.

**Mnemonic** Amorphous = A + Morph = No shape

**Synonyms** Shapeless, Formless

**Antonyms** Structured, Definite



# Ampere

*/ˈæm.peər/*

Noun

<b>Meaning</b>	The basic unit of electric current in the International System of Units (SI)
<b>Example</b>	The bulb requires two amperes to operate.
<b>Sentence</b>	The engineer measured the current in amperes.
<b>Mnemonic</b>	Ampere = Amp for electric current
<b>Synonyms</b>	Unit of current
<b>Antonyms</b>	—
